GE Block Transfer

Chapman accepts the full CSU or UC IGETC General Education certification to satisfy all GE requirements except LBSU 300 and the JWP. Certification must be completed prior to the student's first term admitted, enrolled and attending.

Courses may be approved for more than one area but can only be applied towards one requirement.
