

FAQ's Sheet Summer Swim 2009

1. When and where can I register my children for the summer swim program in person?

You can register with Denise Sailor in CAC104. She is available MW 1-5pm and TTH 10-12 and 2-3 pm.

2. Do I have to write separate checks for each child?

No, we do not require separate checks if you are registering multiple children or one child for several sessions. We do require that there is a separate registration form per child.

3. What do the asterisks mean on the class schedule?

The asterisks indicate the class level is held at that time.

4. Why are the classes names changed?

This summer each of the program's swim instructors will hold a Water Safety Instructor Certification through the American Red Cross. The American Red Cross Learn to Swim program is highly regarded and instructors holding this certification will be fully trained to give your child the proper instruction to meet their swimming needs. All staff will hold certification in Lifeguarding, First-aid, and CPR as well. This will ensure your safety and the safety of your children during your participation in our program.

5. I participated in the program last year but I'm not sure what level my child is at with the new class descriptions.

You can refer to the class conversion chart. This can be used as a reference. However, we cannot guaranteed that the chart is 100% accurate for you child's needs. Depending on years of experience, how long it has been since your child was last in the water, and what skills were taught to him/her in the past they may need to be placed in either the higher or lower level than the chart indicates. 6. Do you provide private lessons?
