6 vs. 6 Tournament Info/Rules

May 15th (Girls) – 16th (Boys), 2010

at the Hawks' Soccer Fields

** This tournament is not CYSA sanctioned. We have our own insurance through Cosumnes River College so CYSA paperwork is not required. The honor system is used to monitor that players are playing in the correct age group.*

** Each Divisional champion will receive championship T-Shirts.*

** Format to determine may vary depending on the number of teams in the age group.*

** A 12-player roster will be used. The 12-player roster need to be designated prior to the teams scheduled first game.*

** Games will start on the scheduled time.*

** Games are 2 x 15 minute halves (no injury time). With a two-minute halftime.*

** All fouls outside of the penalty area will be indirect. Fouls inside of the penalty area, that are of direct nature, will result in a penalty kick (12 yards).*

** Goal kicks are not to be kicked over half field without touching another player or the ground.*

** Balls played out of bounds will be restarted by throw in, goal kick, or corner kick.*

** Goalkeepers cannot distribute over the halflines. Distribution must be touched by a player or the ground before going over the halflines.*

** Walls must be set 5 yards from the ball.*

** Red card suspension will be reviewed by tournament director.*

** Ties will stand in group play. Ties in playoffs and championships will result in a penaltykick shoot-out (5 kicks, if still tied singles kicks).*

** Ball can be played backwards off the kick off.*

** Subs are made on the fly. The player being subbed must be running toward the sideline before the entering player can step on.*

** No offside rule.*

** Any other discrepancies will be ruled on by the tournament directors.*
