As a MESA/CCP student, I agree to...

- Enroll in the 1.0 unit MESA Courses: Interdisciplinary Studies, (Fall semester only) to improve my skills for academic and professional success. These courses are only offered in the Fall semester and are:
 - Interdisciplinary Studies 310 (0.5 units) **AND**
 - **Either** Interdisciplinary Studies 311 (0.5 units) **OR** Interdisciplinary Studies 312 (0.5 units).
