“A Day in the Life of Oak Park” Photographic Event

More than 100 photography students from Cosumnes River College, Public School 7, and Christian Brothers will be in Oak Park Friday, October 17, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. photographing all aspects of the community and serving as documenters of the cultural renaissance occurring in that community.

Sponsored by the CRC Photo Department, Canon Cameras, Photo Source, Maria Christie Photography, Center Court Restaurant and Fourth Avenue Lofts, the students will spend the day taking pictures of what they see as representative of the area.

CRC Photography Professors Patty Felkner, Kathryn Mayo and Jim West, along with Maria Christie will be stationed in the California Community College Foundation’s E-Bus to facilitate the processing of imagery from the students. They will judge the images and choose the best ones from the day-long event.

The goal is to produce a multi-media presentation to show the next evening, Saturday, October 18, during Cosumnes River College’s *Canon on Campus Day*, featuring guest speaker and Pulitzer Prize winning photojournalist David Hume Kennerly. Kennerly will speak at 6:30 p.m. in the Recital Hall.

“A Day in the Life of Oak Park” participants will meet at 4th Street Lofts (on the corner of 35th and 4th) and will be walking around in groups. After the multi-media presentation of the best photographs taken throughout the day, there will be a show in November at C Webb’s Restaurant.
