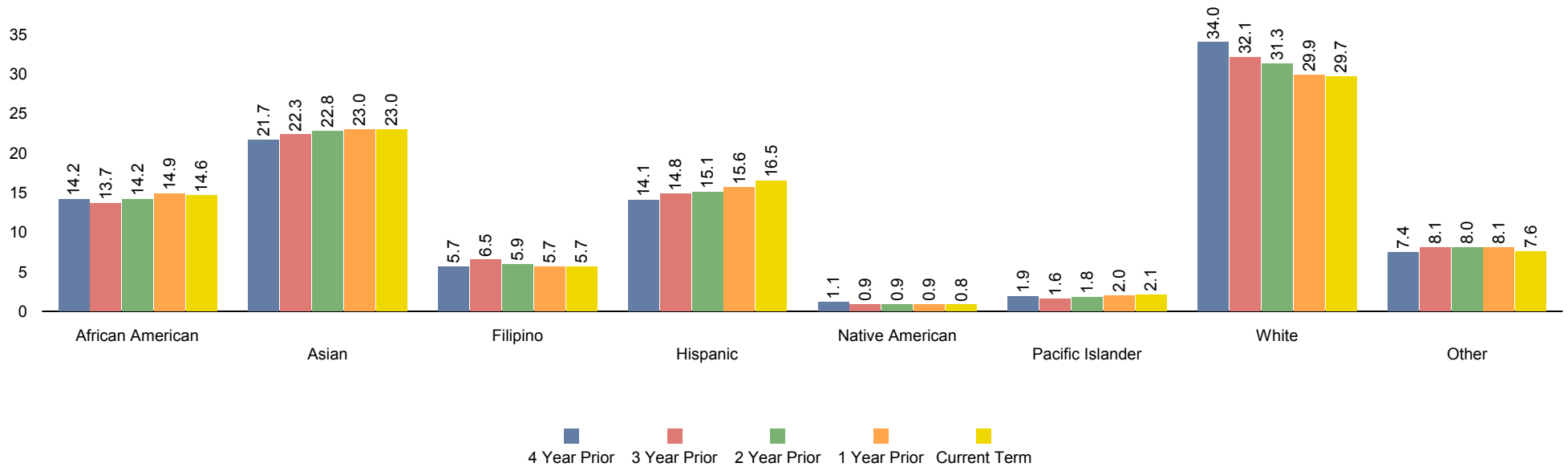

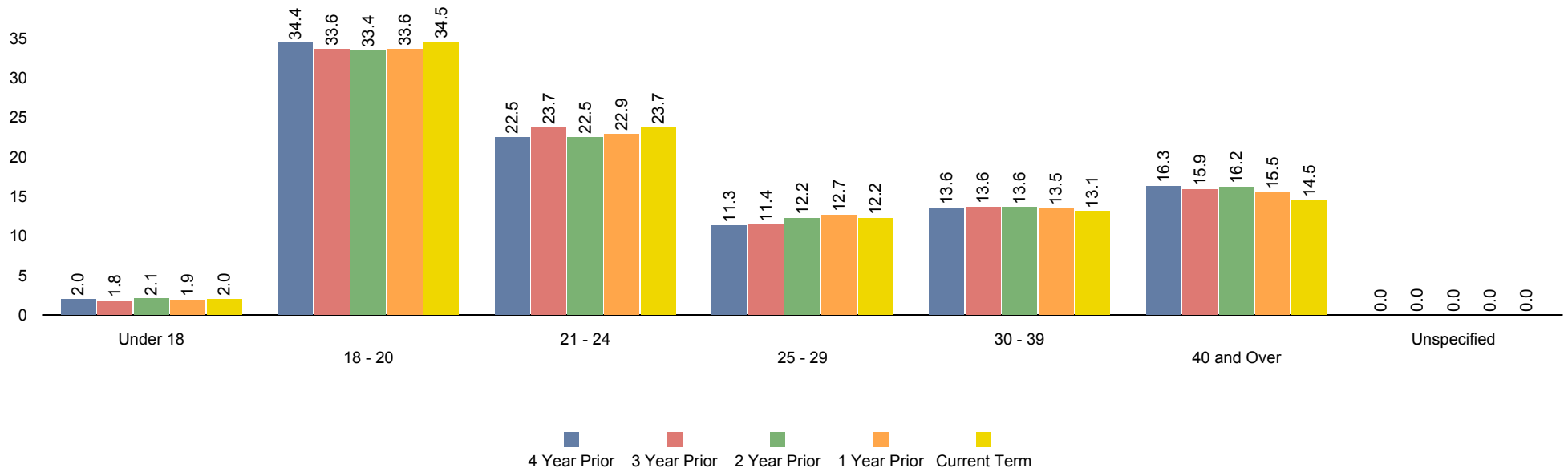

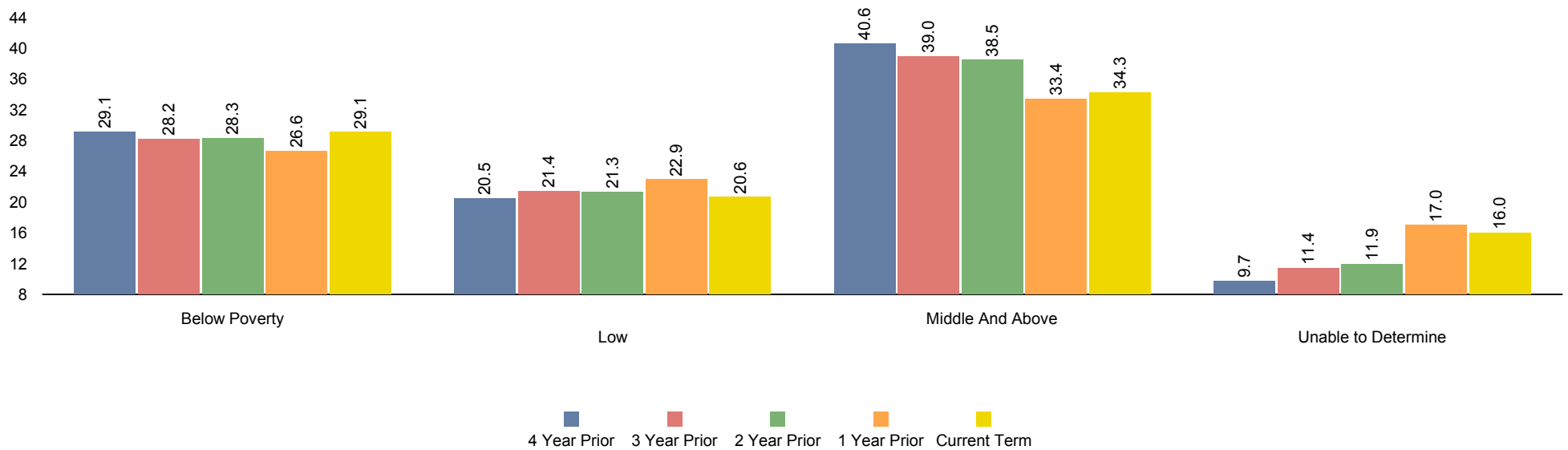

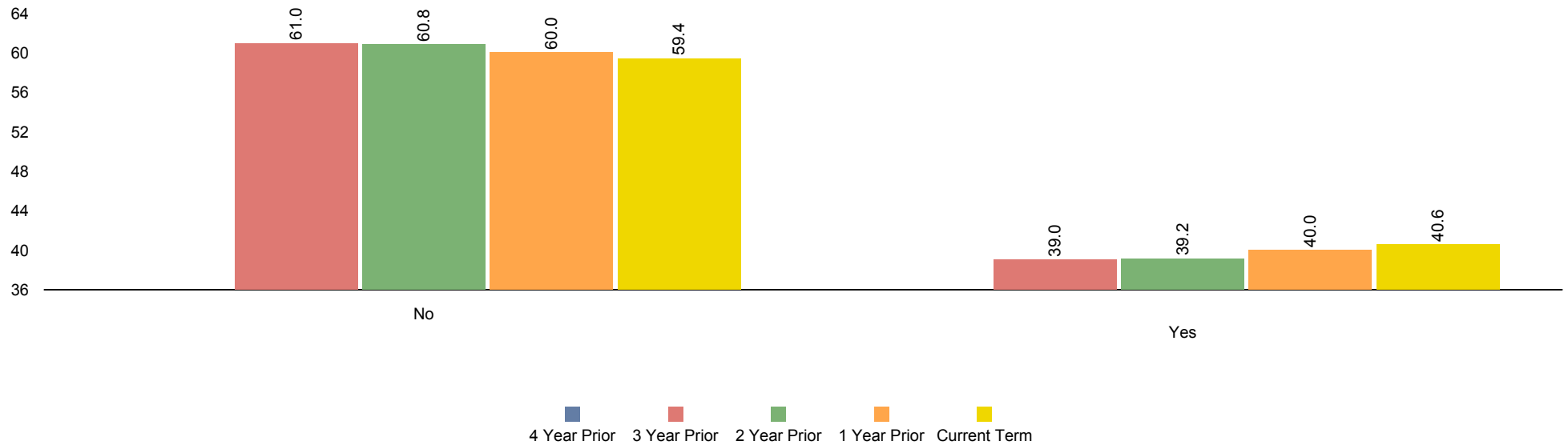

HHS poverty guidelines were used in defining the poverty level. Poverty guidelines are the administrative version of poverty measures issued by the Department of Health & Human Services (HHS); they are a simplification of the poverty thresholds established by the U.S. Census Bureau and are used in determining financial eligibility for certain federal programs. The U.S. Census Bureau defines low income as at or below 200% of poverty. Middle income or higher is defined by the highest income category for which data are collected by LRCCD, which was \$40,000 or higher through Fall 2001 and \$60,000 or higher beginning Fall 2002 and thereafter. Lower LRCCD income categories are also classified as middle for small families (varies by HHS criteria established for each calendar year).

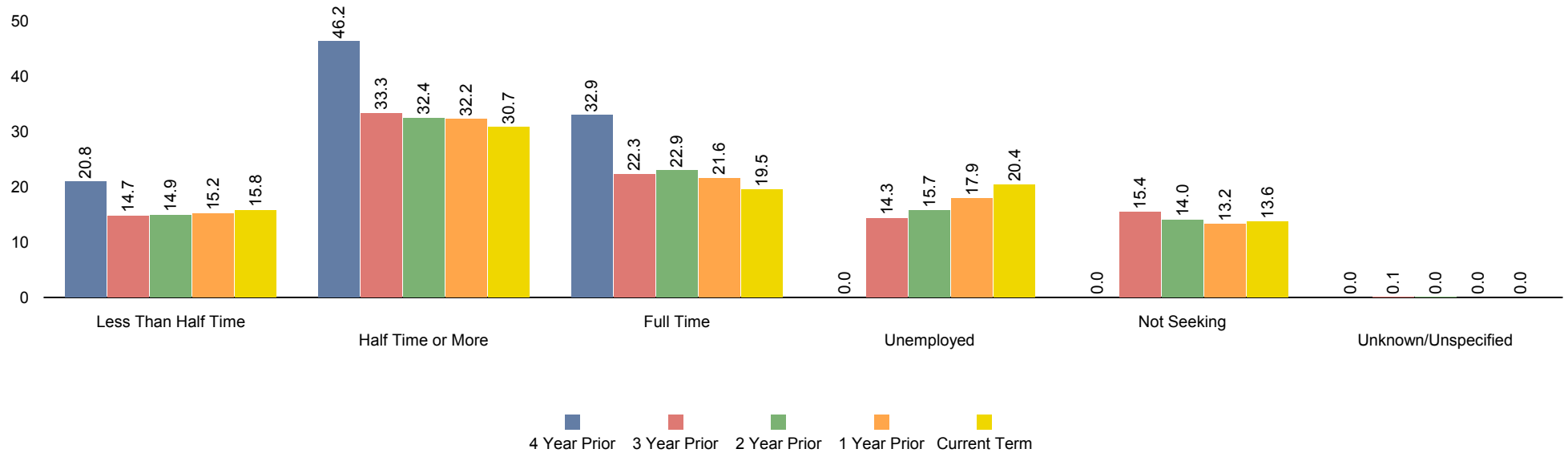

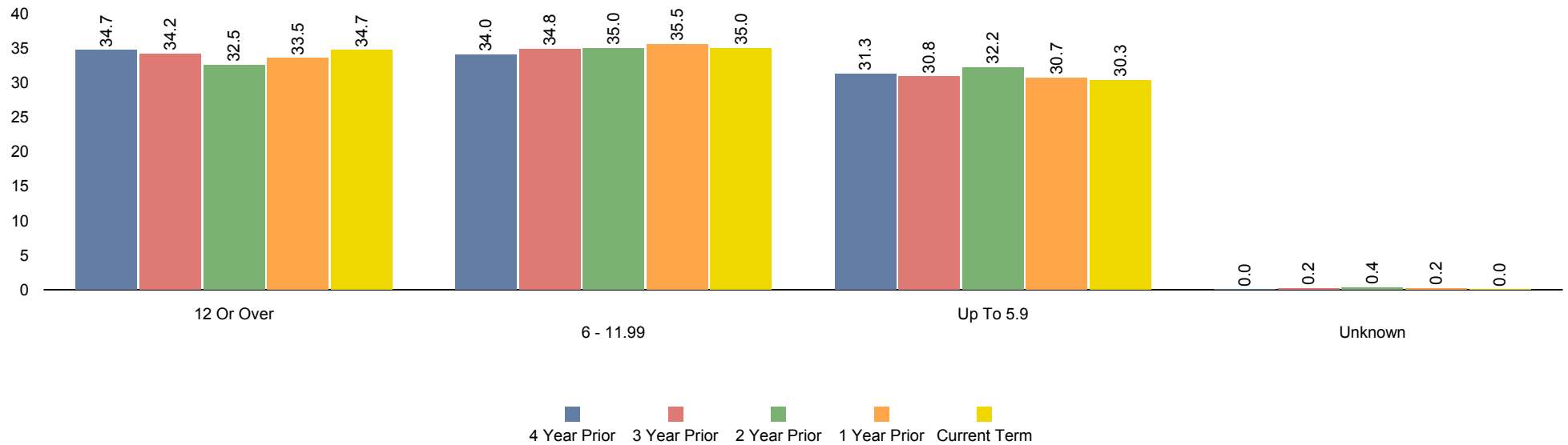

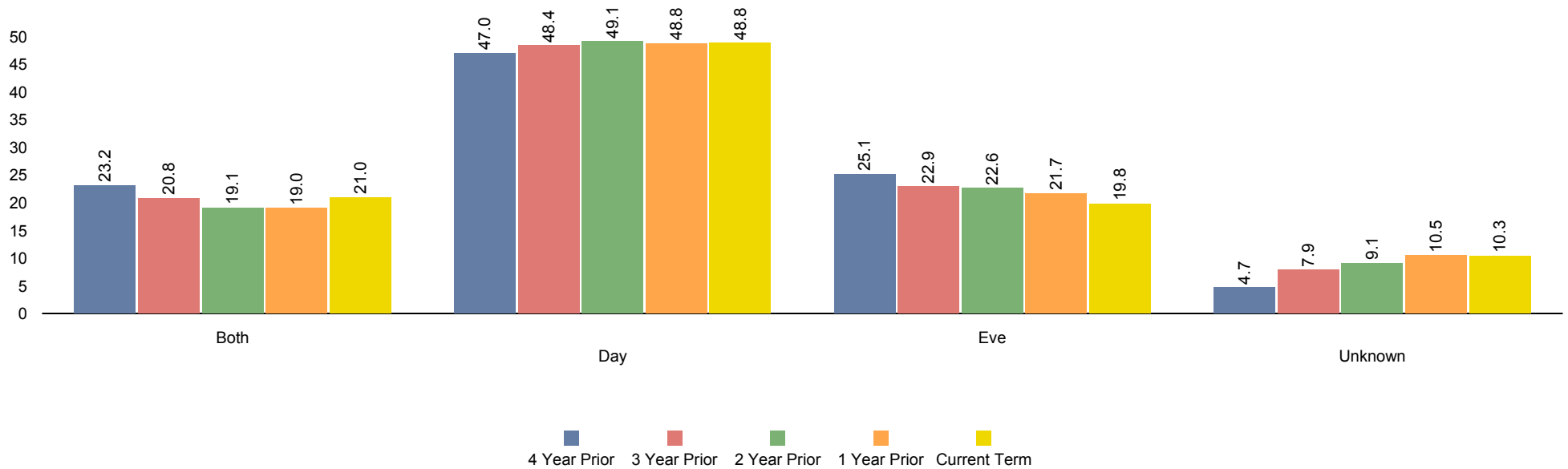

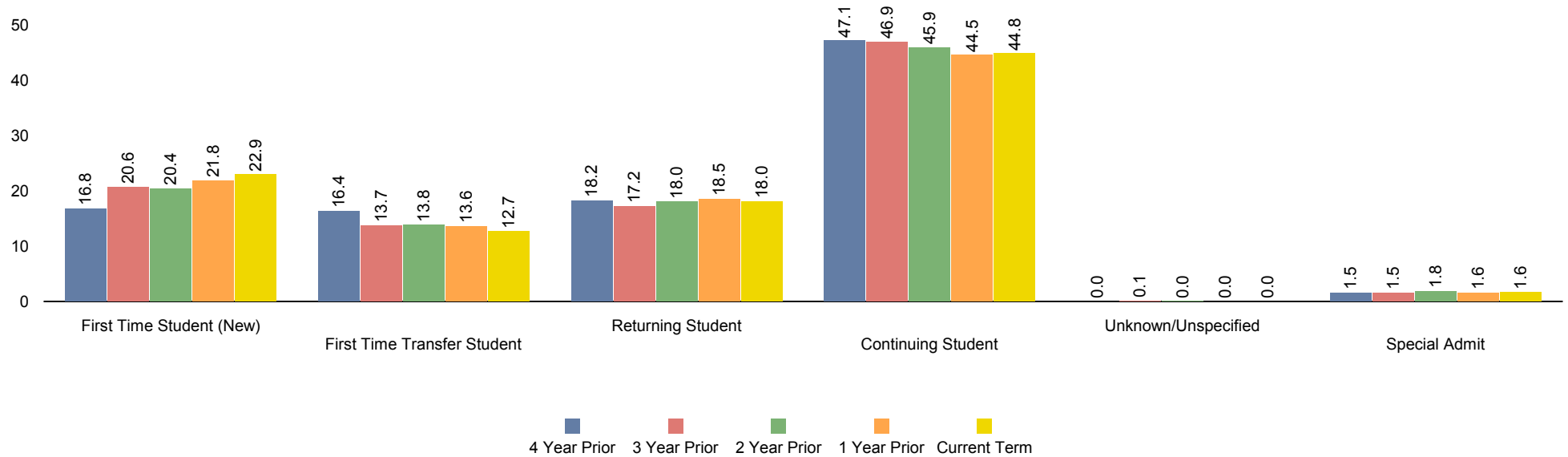

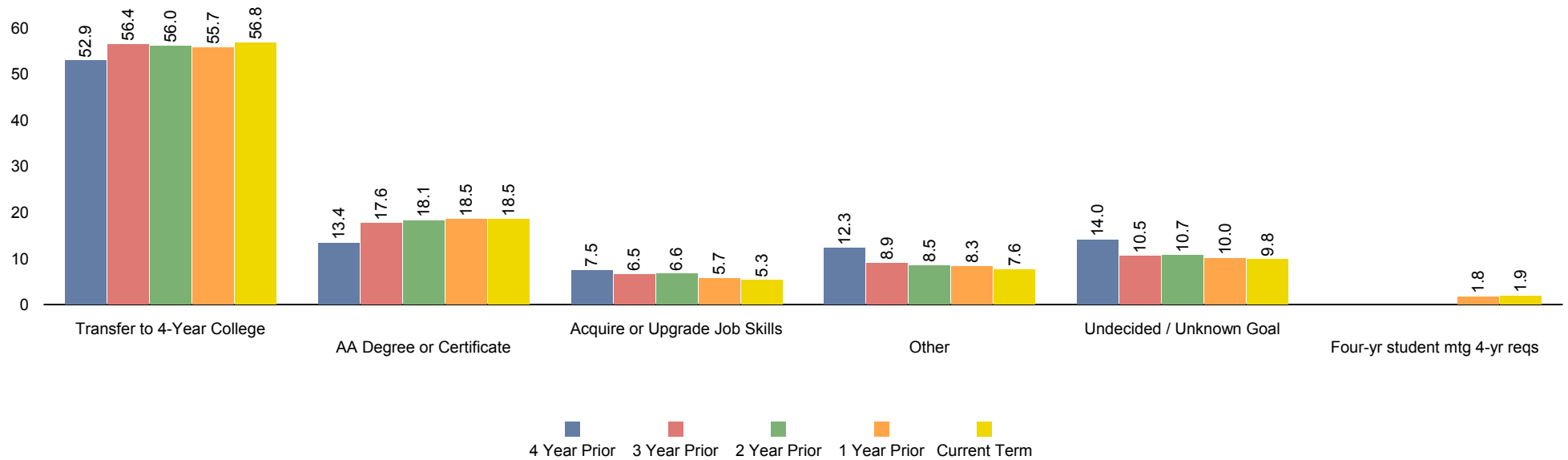

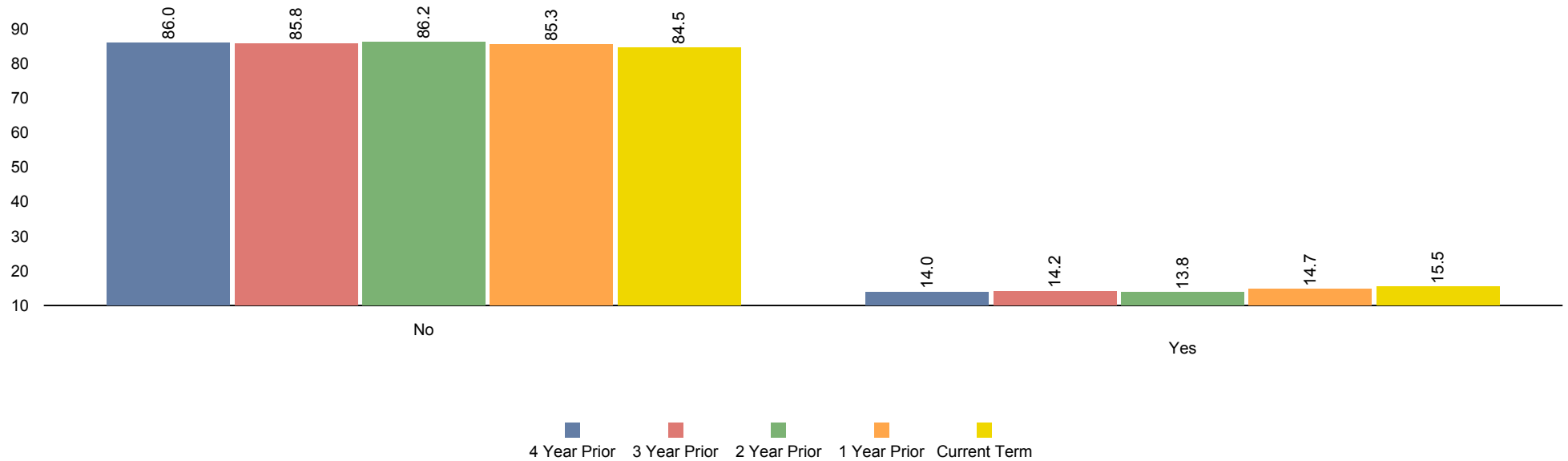

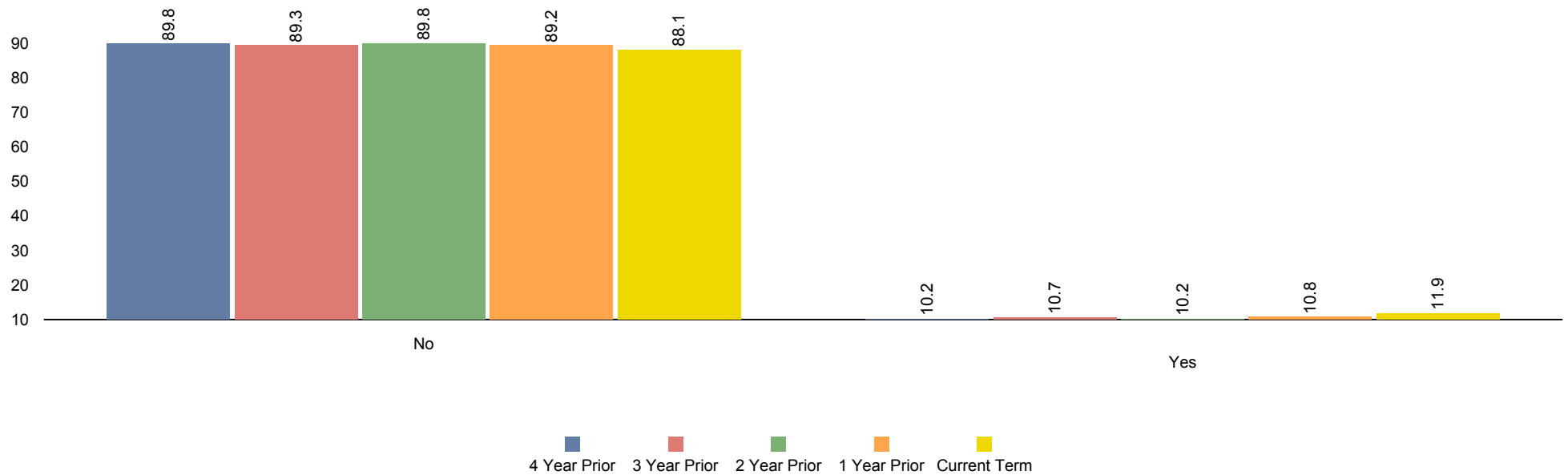
