IMPORTANT INFORMATION

When to arrive: Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before scheduled test time and at least one hour before walk-in testing begins. Walk-in testing is provided on a first-come-first-serve/space available basis.

What to bring: CRC Student ID number (apply online for admission)

Valid photo ID: California driver's license/ID card, military ID, passport, high school photo ID.

Where: CRC Library Building – L-106C behind the Student Support Center. Park in student parking lots A or B (\$2 daily permits must be purchased in parking lot machines)

TESTS OFFERED

ACCUPLACER English

The English test measures reading and writing skills. The first section is composed of passages followed by questions regarding the content. The second section measures your understanding of sentence structure. It is administered on the computer and is not timed. Only one attempt is permitted. You are strongly encouraged to prepare for the ACCUPLACER English assessment. *Note: this assessment may meet competency for graduation, see counselor.*

ACCUPLACER Math

It is administered on the computer and is not timed. Students should allow approximately one hour. Only one attempt is permitted. No calculators are allowed. You are strongly encouraged to prepare for the ACCUPLACER Math assessment.

English as a Second Language Placement (ESL)

The ESL test is for students whose native language is not English and who wish to enroll in ESL classes. The test consists of four sections. Listening, Reading, and Grammar are administered on the computer and are not timed. Writing (essay) is timed for 30 minutes. Only one attempt is permitted. Allow approximately 3 hours. By appt. only call (916) 691-7332 to schedule an appointment.

Graduation Competency for AA/AS Degree

The reading and math graduation competencies may be satisfied by completing specific courses as listed in the graduation competency section of the catalog or by passing the competency examination through the Assessment Center. Please see your counselor to determine whether an examination is needed.

Reading Competency

The test is composed of reading passages followed by questions regarding the content. It is administered on the computer and is not timed. Allow approx. 1.5 hours. Only two attempts are permitted during a lifetime.

Math Competency Exam (Math Comp)

The math competency exam is administered by appointment only. Please call 691-7332 to schedule an appointment for math competency. Math Competency for Graduation may be taken no more than four times in any two year period and no more than twice in a semester or once during the summer session.

MATH COMPETENCY, and ESL tests are NOT available on a "Walk-In" basis. Please call 916-691-7332 to schedule an appointment for Math Competency, and ESL tests.

RESULTS for computerized tests are available immediately upon completion of testing. Paper/Pencil test results are available for pick-up 3 business days after testing.

Note: Walk-in testing is done on a space-available basis. If you arrive and there are no seats available, you may need to return on another date. Calculators and cell phones are not allowed during testing. **Retesting-**Students may retest one time, District-wide, after a 30 day wait period. Students may not test after having started the course sequence. However, they may utilize the academic department course challenge process.
