

CRC GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS 2015-2016

MINIMUM GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A. Satisfactory completion of 60 units of collegiate work

with a "C" (2.0) grade point average in a curriculum that the district accepts toward the degree. At least 12 units must be earned at Cosumnes River College.

Effective summer 2004, students who possess a BA/BS degree or higher from a regionally accredited college or university are deemed to have met General Education and Competency requirements for the AA/AS degree.

Students with degrees earned outside the US will be evaluated on an individual basis.

B. MAJOR

One of the degree programs listed in the Catalog with a **minimum "C" grade in each course** for the major.

III. LIVING SKILLS

A minimum of 3 units – one course from (a) and one course from (b):

a) **One physical education activity course** with a **ADAPT, DANCE, FITNS, PACT, SPORT, TMACT** designation, totaling one unit. *Students with medical excuses on file may enroll in Adapted Physical Education or be exempt from the physical education activity course requirement. Students receiving an exemption for any reason must complete a minimum of 3 units under 6(b).* **AND**

b) **Completion of a minimum of 2 units** selected from the following courses:

D. GRADUATION COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS

Demonstrate college-level competence in reading, written expression and mathematics.

(NOTE: These requirements are effective ONLY for students who either first begin taking classes at CRC, or who re-establish Catalog Rights in the fall semester of 2009.)

1) Reading Competency

Competency is demonstrated by either:

- Completion with a grade of "C" or better in **ENGRD** 200, 310 or 312 or an equivalent college reading course at a regionally accredited college. Students who possess an A.A. /A.S. degree or higher shall be deemed competent in reading. **OR**
- Completion and certification of CSU-GE or IGETC. **OR**
- Obtaining a satisfactory score on a reading examination.

2) Written Expression Competency

Competency is demonstrated by:

Completion with a grade of "C" or better in **ENGWR** 300, 480 (or **HONOR** 375), **BUS** 310, **ESLW** 340, or an equivalent course at a regionally accredited college or university.

3) Mathematics Competency

Competency is demonstrated by either:

- Completion with a grade of "C" or better of **MATH** 110, 120, 125, 144, or designated higher level mathematics course (incl. **STAT** 300); **ECON** 310, **PSYC** 330, or a college-level math course at a regionally accredited college **OR**
- Obtaining a satisfactory score on a mathematics competency examination
