

CRC Desktop Browser Support (Effective Spring 2014)

CRC faculty and staff use a variety of Web-based software applications and services. Certain Web browsers can cause some functionality to be downgraded, limited, or available only through alternative steps when using these applications. Accordingly, the below matrix summarizes support of commonly used browsers as well as recommended browser use to ensure optimal performance.
