Campaign Rules

In order to ensure that student elections are fair, we have made a set of rules for every candidate to follow. It is imperative you review and comply with all relevant LRCCD Policies and Regulations 2311, in section 5 regarding campaigning. In addition to these regulations, the following rules apply to campaigning and posting. Rules and regulations are in place to ensure a fair election process. Breaking any of the rules may result in termination of your candidacy and/or other action. The Election/Campaign Violation Report should be utilized to report alleged violations.

- Campaigning and the posting of all materials may begin the week prior to elections and will end 24 hours after the close of elections when all materials must be removed (See election Timeline). You are responsible for removing all of your own campaign materials.
- Your campaign should be positive and focus on you. No negative campaigning in any way, shape, or form will be permitted. Negative campaigning includes foul language, slander, covering up or removing other candidate's postings, or anything that may be considered illegal or unethical.
- Campaigning is not to interrupt the learning environment and is not permitted in the LRC or computer labs. Campaigning in classrooms is by instructor permission only.
- The Student Life & Leadership Center provides CRC student candidates poster paper and paint for six (6) 3' x 3' posters and two (2) 3' x 6' banners; a maximum of 30 copies of a flyer on white or pastel paper.
- The Student Life & Leadership Center, the Associated Students of CRC Student Senate, and Clubs and Events Board **cannot provide any other materials or equipment use.**

Posting Rules

- All postings require BLUE PAINTER'S TAPE
- Postings in a language other than English must include English translation.
- Campaign materials are not to be placed at a height requiring a ladder or mechanical device. Candidates are to be prudent in respect to safety.
- Chalking is ***not*** permitted.
- Flyers may be distributed hand-to-hand but may not be left unattended for pickup at any location.
- **Brick Walls:** Use **blue** painter's tape – paper postings maximum size: 36" x 72" located in the following areas at CRC Main campus:
 - Business/Social Science (BS)
 - Communication, Visual and Performing Arts (VPAC)
 - Learning Resource Center (LRC)
 - Library Building (L) - First one and one-half floors
 - Physical Education/Athletics (PE)
 - Cafeteria (CC)
 - Science (S)
 - Technology (T)
